Congratulations to Ron Bottorff, Chairman Friends of the Santa Clara River on receiving Ventura County's Earth Day Award

SCOPE is proud to have been a coalition member of Friends of the Santa Clara River since 1993. Among the achievements of this group is the restoration of the 230 acre Hedrick Ranch Natural Area that is helping to re-establish several endangered bird species, including the Least Bell's Vireo and the Southwestern Willow Flycatcher.

Ron Bottorff founded Friends of the Santa Clara River (FSCR) in 1993, a non-profit, public interest organization dedicated to the protection, enhancement and management of the resources of the Santa Clara River. He is widely recognized for his commitment to preserving California's biological diversity. The Santa Clara River is one of only two natural river systems remaining in Southern



California, and was selected by American Rivers in 2005 as one of the nation's most endangered rivers. FSCR is currently working on a major habitat restoration project at the Hedrick Ranch Natural Area. Mr. Bottorff also participated for 13 years on the Santa Clara River Enhancement and Management Plan. For more information on the Friends visit their website at fscr.org
